With respect to the above cited subject and reference, it is to bring to the kind notice to all the principals/chairmen of all the affiliated colleges /PG departments that all under graduate 2 and 4th semesters, B.P.Ed 2 semester, all post graduate 2nd semesters and M.C.A 4th semesters regular students are being promoted to the higher semesters on the basis of the grades of the students which would be composite of 50% marks relating to current internal assessment marks and 50% marks on the performance of previous semester which is as per the guidelines of the committee and government order. This is applicable only for the current academic session 2019-20 as a one- time measure.

The yardsticks followed to promote the students of intermediate semester and the guidelines followed are attached along with this notification.

<u>Guidelines – Promoting students to higher semester</u>

- Promoting students of current semester to next semester shall be based on the previous semester'stotal performance and current semester's Internal Assessment (IA) marks
- 2. Promotion shall be applied only for the fresh students (who are appearing in the examination for the first time) as examination for repeater students is already conducted
- 3. Promotion will be considered only for fee paid students
- 4. Maximum and Minimum marks of the Subject / Degree including its elements such as Theory, IA, Viva, Practical should not be altered.
- 5. For both theory and practical marks, the pervious performance shall be scaled to 50% and the current exam's IA shall also be scaled to 50%. The marks thus arrived for 100 shall be treated as total marks for the course / subject. I.A. marks shall be deducted from this total marks to arrive at Theory / Practical marks
- 6. The result computation criteria shall remain unchanged as it is mandatory to follow university approved regulations.
- 7. Marks card that will be issued after promotion should be in the same format that was given earlier for the previous exam
- 8. As per the guidelines, when the result is computed, the students can either pass or fail in the exam. Failed students may appear in the next exam that will be conducted by University as per the normal examination guidelines.
- 9. The IA marks awarded by the colleges / departments shall remain unchanged. The IA marks will be retained and used in future exams, if the student fails to pass in the current examination
- 10. Revaluation / Retotalling options are not available under this scheme
- 11. Appropriate supporting documents shall be prepared and preserved
